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Medical Emergencies

A visit to our primary care office will typically take less time and result in a lower outof-pocket expense when compared to an Emergency Room.

Below is a guide to help you distinguish emergencies from routine care.

Emergency care is provided in a hospital emergency room when life or long term health is at risk, for example:

- Fractures and head injuries
- Unconsciousness
- Severe burns
- o Serious injury or bleeding

- o Severe breathing difficulties
- o Stroke
- o Symptoms of a heart attack

We are here for you 24/7. If you have an urgent health need, please call us. Urgent Care can be provided by your PCP and involves non-life threatening illness or injury that needs prompt medical attention, but is not an immediate threat to your health. We reserve same-day appointments for minor illnesses such as colds, coughs, flu-like symptoms, earaches, headaches, back or joint pain, fevers, sprains and other minor injuries. If these occur after hours, we have an on-call physicians you can speak with.

When a medical emergency occurs, it's not always easy to think straight. If time allows, call us first. We can help you determine if you should go to the Emergency Room or see your PCP. If you think you are having a heart attack or stroke, call 911 or seek medical attention immediately. Below are warning signs to help guide you.







Five Reasons Why You Should See Your Doctor Every Year

As your partners in health, we believe a yearly visit to your doctor is a critical piece of maintaining and managing your health for the long-term. Our focus on wellness exams at Griffin Faculty Physicians is on the *prevention* of serious diseases, so you stay healthy, avoid or delay the onset of diseases, and take control of your health. Below are the top five reasons why you should see your doctor each year:

- 1. Establish baselines. Getting a routine physical will help establish a baseline that will aid you and your doctor in making future healthcare decisions. Further, having regular check-ups can uncover changes in your health overtime.
- 2. Strengthen relationship between you and your doctor. People who get along with their doctors are more likely to go see them, be honest with them and listen to their advice. To get the most out of your annual exam, it's important to talk openly with your doctor so that he or she can personalize your care.
- 3. Set your health goals and work with your doctor to achieve them. As your personal care partner, your doctor will play an important role in helping you set and achieve your health goals for the near and short term. Similar to financial planning, setting personal health goals is an important part of planning foryour future.
- **4.** Educate Yourself. Use the annual exam to ask questions about your health, and learn more about your body and what you should be aware of. The more you know, the better you'll be able to identify any possible warning signs in the future.
- 5. Discuss Screenings. When it comes to your body, what you don't know could in fact hurt you. The annual wellness exam is a good time to talk about what screenings might be right for you, including those that may not be top of mind, such as a colonoscopy or osteoporosis screening.

Note: If you are a Medicare recipient, you are entitled to an annual wellness exam at no cost. If you have commercial insurance, you are entitled to an annual exam every year or every other year, generally at no cost to you. *Please call your insurance company to clarify any questions about your coverage.*

Insurance Information

- Insurance Accepted: We accept most major insurance plans, including Medicare, Medicaid, Blue Cross/Blue Shield, Aetna, Cigna and United Healthcare. If you are not insured by a plan we accept, payment in full is expected at each visit. If you are insured by a plan we accept, but don't have an upto-date insurance card, payment in full for each visit is required until we can verify your coverage.
- **Know Your Coverage:** Knowing your insurance benefits is your responsibility. Insurance coverage varies between insurers and specific plans. If you have questions about your coverage, please contact your insurance company.
- Uninsured: There are many ways to receive affordable healthcare. If you do not have insurance coverage, payment in full is expected at each visit. Please visit www.accesshealthct.com, or call 1-855-909-2428, to learn about health insurance plans that may be available in Connecticut.
- **Copayments and Balances:** Co-payments, insurance and deductibles must be paid at the time of service. We accept cash, checks and most credit cards.

Understanding Insurance Terminology

- <u>Deductible:</u> Deductible is the amount you pay for health care service before your health insurance begins to pay. For example if you have a \$1000 deductible, you are responsible to pay the first \$1000 of medical expenses. .
- <u>Coinsurance</u>: Coinsurance is your share of the cost of a health care service after your deductible is met. For example: You have met your deductible and have 20% coinsurance. Your health insurance plan rate is \$100 for an office visit, your share will be \$20 and the health insurance will pay \$80.
- <u>Copayment</u>: Copayment is a fixed amount you pay for a covered health care service. This amount varies between plans and many times is different for a PCP visit and a Specialist visit. For example: Your plan has a \$20 PCP Copay/\$40 Specialist Copay. Please note that your health insurance carrier may waive your copayment for certain preventative visits.
- <u>Preventative Services</u>: Most health insurance plans waive copays and coinsurance for preventative visits and some preventative tests. *Please check with your insurer to determine what is* covered as "preventative."
